Each student is expected to respect the rights and privileges of other students, teachers, and UT Tyler University Academy staff. All teachers, administrators, and other UT Tyler University Academy personnel are expected to respect the rights and privileges of students.

Sec. 1. STUDENT HANDBOOK

The Superintendent or designee shall develop student handbooks with information on curriculum, grading, extracurricular activities, and other such topics that students and parents are likely to need during the school year. The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that no student handbook information is in conflict with policy or the Student Code of Conduct. In case of conflict between a Board policy or the Student Code of Conduct and provisions of student handbooks, policy and/or the Student Code of Conduct shall prevail.

Sec. 2. <u>DISTRIBUTION</u>

Student handbooks shall be made available on the UT Tyler University Academy website at the beginning of the school year; hard copy shall be provided upon request. Amendments to the Student Handbook shall be communicated promptly to students and parents.
