

**Sec. 1. GENERAL PRINCIPLES**

Each student is expected to respect the rights and privileges of other students, teachers, and UT Tyler University Academy staff. All teachers, administrators, and other UT Tyler University Academy personnel are expected to respect the rights and privileges of students.

**Sec. 2. STUDENT HANDBOOK**

The Superintendent or designee shall develop student handbooks with information on curriculum, grading, extracurricular activities, and other such topics that students and parents are likely to need during the school year.

**Sec. 3. DISTRIBUTION**

Student handbooks shall be made available on the UT Tyler University Academy website at the beginning of the school year; hard copy shall be provided upon request. Amendments to the Student Handbook shall be communicated promptly to students and parents.

**Sec. 4. PRIORITIZATION**

The Superintendent or designee shall ensure that no student handbook provision conflicts with board policy or the Student Code of Conduct. In the case of conflict between a Board policy, Student Code of Conduct, and/or the Student Handbook, the provisions shall prevail in the following order, with the final authority residing in the Student Code of Conduct: (1) Board policy, (2) student handbook, and (1) Student Code of Conduct.
