Please be advised that if you choose to opt out of health services, and your child becomes ill or sustains a non-life-threatening injury during the school day, the campus nurse or appropriate staff will not be permitted to assess or provide care. In such cases, you will be contacted immediately and will be required to pick up your child from school without delay. Additionally, if your child is sent home due to suspected illness, they may not return to school without a written statement from a licensed healthcare provider confirming that the student is not ill or contagious. *Life-threatening emergencies do not require parental consent*.
