The UTTUA Health Services Department provides the following general health-related services, routine screenings, and first aid and emergency care services to your scholar's campus. State law requires that parents **MUST** consent to their scholar receiving health-related services before they can be seen by Health Services personnel or other appropriately trained District Staff.

If you do not Consent to Health Services, UTTUA Staff CANNOT provide general health-related services to your scholar. You will be notified and required to come assist your scholar.

Note that the District may also provide other services, if available and deemed necessary by qualified licensed personnel (such as the school nurse), particularly in the case of an emergency which immediately threatens the health or life of your scholar. UTTUA personnel will intervene in the event of such an emergency for all scholars. Below are

Please be advised that if you choose to opt out of health services, and your child becomes ill or sustains a non-life-threatening injury during the school day, the campus nurse or appropriate staff will not be permitted to assess or provide care. In such cases, you will be contacted immediately and will be required to pick up your child from school without delay. Additionally, if your child is sent home due to suspected illness, they may not return to school without a written statement from a licensed healthcare provider confirming that the student is not ill or contagious. ***Life-threatening emergencies do not require parental consent.***
